#### Breast Cancer

- 1 in 8** PA women will develop breast cancer in her lifetime
- 11,641** Number of diagnosed female breast cancer cases in PA in 2021
- #2** Breast cancer was the second leading cause of cancer death in women.
- 90.2%** Five-year net survival rate among PA women
